

## SECONDARY ANGELICO EXHIBITION 2020 Important Points to Note

*Due to Covid 19 the following will be implemented:*

- *The Opening Night presentation ceremony will be cancelled.*
- *The Exhibition will not be open for public viewing.*
- *A 3D Virtual Tour of the exhibition will be made available on the Catholic Arts website enabling full visual access to the display.*
- *Angelico entry fees will be waived.*
- *Award recipients will be notified after judging.*
- *A minimum number of volunteers will be permitted on set up day. (Date to be advised). If your entry is fragile and requires specific attention, please contact our office to indicate your desire to attend set up day to display your artwork. This will ensure we comply with social gathering requirements.*

### ONLINE ENTRIES

- Teachers will be sent a welcome email with login details. This email will also provide a link directly to the online entry system.

  - On successful submission of each entry, a confirmation email will be sent with an attachment of the Category Labels A, B & C form.
  - These labels need to accompany the artwork when delivered to the Catholic Arts Office (See Identification of Artworks).
  - A copy of the entry will also be emailed to the Art Co-Ordinator for the school.
- With the exception of the dates for this year's exhibition, all additions to the package have been highlighted in yellow.
- It is still a requirement for the General Category Labels A, B to be attached to the artwork and label C to be submitted on delivery.

- Electrical tagging is compulsory for any artworks that require a power source i.e. cords/power boards/digital displays/laptops etc. Please ensure the electrical tag is clearly visible on all equipment. If the artwork is not tagged it will not be exhibited. This is a venue requirement.
- Artworks are to be collected by the schools/students at the completion of the exhibition Saturday 15 August, between 9am and 11am, from the Holy Rosary Hall, Williamstown Road, Doubleview (adjacent to the Catholic Arts Office)
- Maximum weights apply for individual entries and group submissions.
  - 2D artworks – 15kg
  - 3D artworks – 20kg
- In the Group Submission category maximum dimensions now apply.
  - 2D artworks – 1m wide x 2 m high
  - 3D artworks – 1m<sup>3</sup>
- If nominating for either the Fra Angelico Award or the Caritas Awards, the artist statement must reflect the criteria.
