

SECONDARY ANGELICO EXHIBITION 2019 Important Points to Note

ONLINE ENTRIES

- **Teachers will be sent a welcome email with login details. This email will also provide a link directly to the online entry system. <https://angelico.catholicarts.wa.edu.au> (If you have not received an email with login details please contact the Catholic Arts Office via email catholicarts@cewa.edu.au)**
 - **On successful submission of each entry, a confirmation email will be sent with an attachment of the Category Labels A, B & C form.**
 - **These labels need to accompany the artwork when delivered to the Catholic Arts Office (See Identification of Artworks).**
 - **A copy of the entry will also be emailed to the Art Co-Ordinator for the school.**
 - **Please ensure all details are correct as whatever is entered online will be used in the production of the catalogue.**
- **With the exception of the dates for this year's exhibition, all additions to the package have been highlighted in yellow.**
- **It is still a requirement for the General Category Labels A, B to be attached to the artwork and label C to be submitted on delivery.**
 - **A Group Submission Category is available for years 7 – 9 only. Please see guidelines for entry criteria.**
 - **Artwork must be delivered to the Catholic Arts office between Mon Aug 5 and Wed Aug 7. Office hours are strictly 8am – 4pm. As the artwork will be transported to the venue on Wed Aug 7 at 5pm, late deliveries will need to be made by the school directly to the venue.**

- Electrical tagging is compulsory for any artworks that require a power source i.e. cords/power boards/digital displays/laptops etc. Please ensure the electrical tag is clearly visible on all equipment. If the artwork is not tagged it will not be exhibited. This is a venue requirement.
- Artworks are to be collected by the schools/students at the completion of the exhibition on Saturday 31st August between 9am-11am at Forrest Centre. A fee of \$150 per artwork for transport costs will be invoiced for all artworks not collected by 11am.
- Restrictions for invitations for Opening Night is highlighted in the guidelines.
- Maximum weights apply for individual entries and group submissions.
 - 2D artworks – 15kg
 - 3D artworks – 20kg
- In the Group Submission category maximum dimensions now apply.
 - 2D artworks – 1m²
 - 3D artworks – 1m³
- Refer to flyer regarding information on the St John of God Health Care Visual Arts Scholarship, for year 11 students entering the Angelico Exhibition.
- A theme is no longer applicable to The Phil Somers Sculpture award. Please ensure you indicate your desire to nominate for this award on the online registration form.
- If nominating for either the Fra Angelico Award or the Caritas Awards, the artist statement must reflect the criteria.
