## **ONLINE ENTRIES**

- Teachers will be sent a welcome email with login details. This
  email will also provide a link directly to the online entry system.

- On successful submission of each entry, a confirmation email will be sent with an attachment of the Category Labels A, B & C form.
- These labels need to accompany the artwork when delivered to the Catholic Arts Office (See Identification of Artworks).
- A copy of the entry will also be emailed to the Art Co-Ordinator for the school.
- With the exception of the dates for this year's exhibition, all additions to the package have been highlighted in yellow.
- It is a requirement for the General Category Labels A, B & C to be attached to the artwork.
- Submission of Artwork: Maximum of 6 pieces of artwork per school. This is inclusive of the Group Submission
- Works nominated for Fra Angelico will automatically be entered into the General Category.
- A Group Submission Category is available for Pre-Primary to Year 6. Please see guidelines for entry criteria. Maximum weight and dimensions apply.

DIMENSIONS: 2D artworks 1m<sup>2</sup> / 3D artwork 1m<sup>3</sup> WEIGHT: 2D artworks 15kg / 3D artworks 20kg

- Black Line Masters and in-class worksheets are not to be submitted for display for the exhibition.
- 2D Artworks dropped off to the Catholic Arts Office <u>must be wrapped or placed</u> in folios. MAXIMUM WEIGHT 15KG
- 3D Artworks must be bubble wrapped and boxed where necessary. MAXIMUM WEIGHT 20KG
- If folios/boxes are to be returned, please ensure they are clearly labelled with the schools name.
- Fragile pieces or artworks that require assembling are to be transported by the teacher / student on the day of set up to Forrest Centre. The committee will not take responsibility for the setup of these submissions.
- Artworks are to be collected by the schools at the completion of the exhibition from the Catholic Arts Office as follows:

Wednesday 21 August – 8am – 4pm Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> August – 8am – 5.30pm Friday 23 August between 8am – 4pm.

- Hanging devices <u>must</u> be correctly placed on artwork. Velcro is to be used <u>only</u> on paper/card artworks. Canvas works <u>must</u> be fitted with wire hanging devices.
- Winning artworks will remain on display until the completion of the Secondary Angelico Exhibition (Friday 30 August 2019). Award winners will be invited to attend the opening night presentation of the Secondary Angelico Exhibition on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> August to receive their prize and must attend in their full winter school uniform.
- A Primary Viewing evening will be on held on Friday 9<sup>rd</sup> August. See handy reference list for details.
