- Thursday 27 February** Festival Information sent to schools (all information available on website)
- Sunday 10 May**
- CLOSING DATE FOR ALL ENTRIES:** Invoices for entry fees will be sent to schools after entries close.
 - All Online Entries must be submitted**
 - The Privacy Information document for Parents and Students must be made available to Festival entrants
 - FINAL DATE REQUESTING SPECIFIC PERFORMANCE DATES.** Note: Performance date requests must be within dates allocated for a Festival section according to the Festival Calendar
 - PAF Coordinators have the capacity to print a list of all Entries submitted On Line. Your Principal (or Nominated Representative or PAF Coordinator on behalf of the Principal) will need to sight this list and confirm by ticking the box to acknowledge acceptance of the Festival's Rules & Procedures.
- Friday 22 May**
- ALL MUSIC SCORES/STAGE PLANS are due today** for those applicable sections. Music cannot be photocopied at a venue prior to a performance
- If music, item information, or entry information are not received by the due date or music/entry is changed after the due date or on the performance day/evening, the performance will not be eligible for an Outstanding Award, Excellence Award or the Perpetual Shield**
- Thursday 18 Jun** Festival Programme of Events Package to schools (includes individual/group section timetables, Information Memorandums etc)
- Thursday 23 Jul** Opening Mass – 31st Performing Arts Festival for Catholic Schools & Colleges
- Monday 29 Jun** Dance Tickets on Sale to Public
